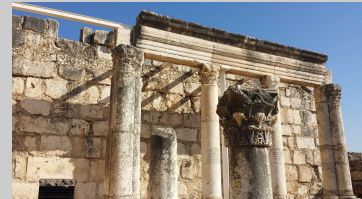

After reading this brochure, we hope you will make the life-changing decision to join Cheryl Anderson to walk in the footsteps of Jesus Christ.

November 7th—19th

This 13 day pilgrimage to the Holy Land has been specifically designed for those wishing travel to Israel on a small group faith based tour.

Day One—Thursday, November 7th
Our journey to the Holy Land begins, as we depart USA and travel to Israel.

Day Two—Friday, November 8th
CAESAREA

Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv. Time permitting, we start our journey of faith with a visit and devotion at **Caesarea**. The city built by Herod the Great and named for his benefactor, Augustus Caesar. Paul was here many times and, in chains, was sent from here to trial in Rome (Acts 10, 21, 23 and 24). This place is the site where the *first conversion to Christianity took place when Peter converted the Gentile Centurion, Cornelius*. (Acts 10:34-44). Today this is an impressive archaeological park on the shore of the Mediterranean Sea, with a Roman Theatre, Hippodrome, Palaces, Roman bathhouses and much more. It is here that the Pontius Pilate Stele was found, an extrabiblical source containing the name of Pilate, a significant artefact that confirms the authenticity of the Bible. *The more you dig out of the ground – the more the Bible proves to be true!* If possible, we will visit the Roman Aquaduct that brought water down from Mount Carmel and then continue to our beautiful home for the next three nights, the Gai Beach Hotel on the Sea of Galilee in Tiberias.

Day Three—Saturday, November 9th
***MOUNT OF BEATITUDES*CAPERNAUM*MENSA*
CHRISTI*MAGDALA*GINOSAR* JORDAN RIVER***

This morning, as we view the sun rising over the Golan Heights and serene Sea of Galilee we will have a short (optional) devotion at sunrise. Then after a hearty Israeli breakfast our time in the Holy Land begins with visits that include the **Mount of Beatitudes**, the site of the *Sermon on the*

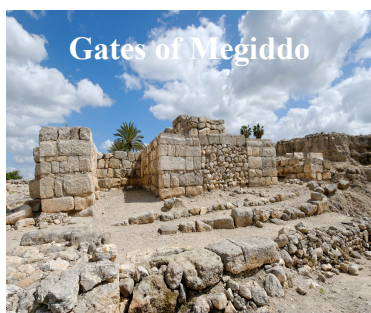
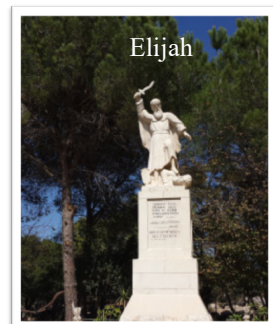

Mount. We will hear how Jesus spoke to the crowd from this very spot, sharing His Kingdom message. A visit to Magdala, *the hometown of Mary Magdalene*, emphasizes the contribution of women to the ministry of Jesus. A stop at **Capernaum**, the headquarters of Jesus' ministry, to visit the *Synagogue where Jesus taught* will highlight many of Jesus' miracles. Capernaum is also where we can view the *house of Peter's mother-in-law*. At **Mensa Christi**, where Jesus prepared breakfast for the disciples, and asked Peter three times, "*Peter, do you love me?*" (John 21), we will enjoy an opportunity to be close to our Lord, in meditation, song and praise. We will visit **Kibbutz Ginosar** where an ancient boat, going back to the time of Jesus, was discovered on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. After viewing this incredible discovery we will **sail across the beautiful Sea of Galilee**, pause in the middle to reflect on Jesus' miracles performed on this very lake, learn Hebrew Folk dances in the sun. After lunch we will go to a special site on the **River Jordan** to *baptize those who desire to take part in this beautiful experience*. After a full day, we return to our hotel for dinner and overnight in Tiberias.



Day Four—Sunday, November 10th
 *CAESAREA***MOUNT CARMEL***MEGIDDO***NAZARETH***

We begin this morning again with a sunrise devotion and wonderful breakfast before driving to the Central Israeli highlands. (We will visit **Caesarea** if we were unable to visit here on Day One.) Our day will include an ascent to the top of **Mt. Carmel** to view the Jezreel Valley from the roof top at the beautiful Carmelite Church dedicated to *Elijah's battle with the prophets of Baal*. After reliving that battle, we will travel to the Valley of Armageddon and **Tel Megiddo** (Revelation 16:16), *a chariot city of King Solomon strategically situated at the crossroads of several ancient trade and military routes, the site of many battles through the centuries and where the End Times battles will occur*. We



will discuss the Biblical prophesies of the last days that will culminate in this very valley. We will walk through the remains of this well-preserved site that figures prominently in Biblical history, exploring the secret tunnel and water system built by King Ahab 3000 years ago. Our day will include a visit to **Nazareth**, the city of Joseph and Mary, to visit *Mary's Well*. On the way back to Tiberias and the Sea of Galilee, we will drive through **Cana**, *the site of Jesus' First Miracle, "Turning water into wine at the wedding ceremony,"* before returning to our beautiful hotel for dinner and overnight on the Sea of Galilee.

Day Five—Monday, November 11th

*KURSI*BET SHE'AN*WADI QELT*(QUMRAN)*MT OF OLIVES*JERUSALEM*

Today we go up to Zion - To Jerusalem! After our last sunrise devotion on the Sea of Galilee and a lakeside breakfast, we will drive to the east side of the Sea of Galilee, to the Golan Heights, and visit **Kursi**. We will share a devotion in the beautiful Byzantine church and monastery dedicated *to Jesus' miracle of healing Legion*, and driving the demons into a herd of pigs. (Luke 8: 26—37). We will view (or climb) the nearby cliff, said to be where the swine fell into the lake. Continuing on to Jerusalem, we will stop at **Bet She'an**, a superbly preserved Canaanite, Roman and Byzantine city in the Jordan Valley. Here is where the *bodies of King Saul and his son Jonathan* were hung on the city walls by the Philistines (2nd Samuel 1, 21-22). We will explore the Cardo, Decomanus, Agora, climb the 160 steps (optional) to the top of the Tel and view Mt. Gilboa. After this spectacular site, we continue through the Jordan Valley, and the beautiful hills of Samaria.

Time permitting, we will visit **Qumran**, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. The Scrolls, considered by many as the most important archaeological find in history, consist of each and every book of the Bible, including the entire book of Isaiah. This priceless discovery, silently waiting for 2000 years in God's best "climate control," the desert, put an end to claims of Bible deniers who assert that the Bible is merely "stories" or "myths". We will walk through and experience the community's Scriptorium, and purification baths while viewing the caves. Many believe the ancient Essene Sect established this community that produced the scrolls and hid them in the caves for safety and posterity. After seeing this spectacular site, we start ascending up to Zion following the old Roman road. We can view the curves of the ancient road leading from Galilee to Zion that was used at the time of Jesus and pass by **Wadi Qelt** (*The Valley of the Shadow of Death*). We enter



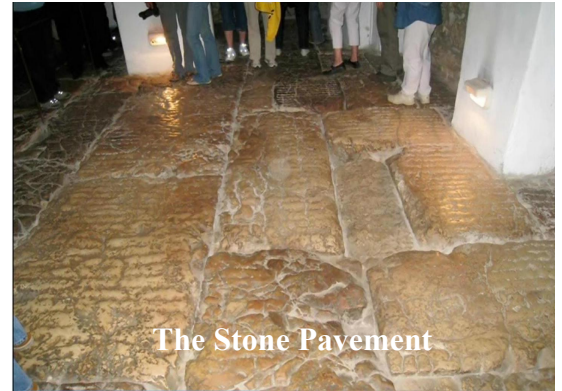
Jerusalem, driving first to the observation point on the **Mount of Olives** where we will sit and look toward the breath-taking **Temple Mount** and **Old City**. We will hear a message focusing on the many Biblical events that happened on the Mt. of Olives, and possible future events. After a full day we will check into the Jerusalem Leonardo Plaza, and enjoy a beautiful dinner and rest up for our Jerusalem adventures!



Day Six—Tuesday, November 12th

ISRAELI MUSEUM* LITHOSTROTOS* ST. ANNE'S CHURCH & POOLS OF BETHESDA* ST. STEPHEN'S GATE

After enjoying another sumptuous Israeli breakfast, our day will include a visit to the **Israeli Museum** to observe the *model of ancient Jerusalem as it looked during the time of Christ*, and to view some of the artefacts available in the museum, including (1) Tel Dan Stele, the only extrabiblical mention of King David; (2) the bone-box (ossuary) of Caiaphas, the high priest who condemned Jesus; (3) the oldest (from 690 BC) written biblical quotation in existence and (4) the Pontius Pilate Stele from Caesarea. We will make our way to the **Lithostrotos—the Stone Pavement**, or *Gabbatha* (John 19:13 [NLT]), which is found 30 feet below the present streets of Jerusalem, in the **Fortress of Antonia** where *Pilate made his judgment over Jesus*. We will reflect with a devotion about the final moments of Jesus on that “Holy Ground.” From there we will walk to the **Pools of Bethesda** where Jesus healed the lame man (John 5) located beside the **Crusader Church of St. Anne's**. A church with amazing acoustics where we will sing and praise the Lord. Our day would not be complete without a walk through **St. Stephens Gate** also known as the Lions Gate, where Stephen was martyred.

Day Seven—Wednesday, November 13th

MASADA* DEAD SEA SWIMMING* QUMRAN* EIN GEDI

After another amazing Israeli Breakfast, today we explore "no-man's land", in the wilderness of Judea. We will ride the cable car up to the amazing fortress of **Masada** high above the Dead Sea. This World Heritage site, built by Herod the Great, tells the remarkable story of the brave zealots who, in 70 AD, fought the Romans for the right to worship the one true God of Israel. Looking over the edge, we will view Herod's Summer Palace, the ingenious desert water system, sit and pray in one of the most ancient synagogues of the world, and see the breaching point and the Roman Ramp that signalled the demise of the 900 men, women and children who had taken refuge on Masada. We will enjoy free time to swim and float in the mineral rich waters of the **Dead Sea**, and experience you won't soon forget. Our day will include a visit to **Ein Gedi** and David's Falls where we will see the many caves that David hid in while fleeing from King Saul (I Samuel 24) and where he wrote many of the Psalms. (*Qumran will be added if unable to visit on Day 5.*) After this fun, adventure filled day we will return to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight at our beautiful hotel.

Day Eight—Thursday, November 14th

TEMPLE MOUNT*THE VIA DOLOROSA*OLD CITY & JEWISH QUARTER*WESTERN WALL

This morning we head up to the **Temple Mount**, Mt. Moriah (where Abraham brought his son Isaac as a sacrifice), and explore this sacred mount where the first and second temples stood and where the Golden Dome stands today. We will walk to the Pinnacle where *Jesus was tempted by Satan*, see the Golden Gates that *Jesus walked through each time He visited the Temple* and stand where the Holy of Holies is thought to be. As we walk off the Temple Mount, we will enjoy the sights and sounds of the old city. We will walk the Stations of the Cross on the **Via**

Dolorosa down the narrow city streets of Old Jerusalem. As we come through the **Jewish Quarter** we will pass by the Golden Menorah on the steps that lead to the Plaza in front of the **Western Wall**. What visitors see of the Western Wall today, is only a small part of what existed during the Second Temple period. At this site, we will spend time praying and putting our prayer requests into the cracks between the ancient stones of the wall, the place closest to where the Jews can come to their adored Temple, the one Jesus visited. Near the Western Wall we will view the immense stones from the destruction of the Second Temple, excavated and found in exactly the same position where they landed when the Roman soldiers pushed them over the side while destroying the Temple in 70 AD.



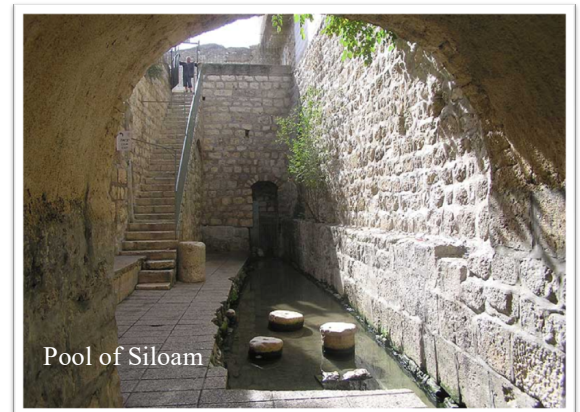
Day Nine—Friday, November 15th

WALK THE OLD CITY WALLS *HEZEKIAH'S TUNNEL* POOL OF SILOAM*HOUSE OF CAIAPHAS

Before we walk the ramparts of the **Old City Walls**, retracing the footsteps of those who have defended the city of Jerusalem over the centuries, we will visit the **House of Caiaphas**, also known as the **Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu**.

The courtyard of this spectacular church is thought to be the site of Peter's triple denial of Jesus, recorded in all four Gospels, specifically Mark 14: 27—31. Under the church is a dungeon thought to be the cell where Jesus was detained overnight following His arrest and trial. Ascending to the top of the walls at the **Jaffa Gate** across from the Tower of David, crossing over the Zion Gate and descending from the walls near the **Dung Gate**.

From there it is a short walk to the ancient city of David, where his palace has been identified and a fascinating ongoing excavation is taking place. Then we will cross the threshold of time as we walk through **Hezekiah's Tunnel**, a 1750 foot channel carved through rock in order to bring water into Jerusalem during the 700 BC siege by the Assyrians. This amazing feat of Biblical engineering ends at the **Pool of Siloam** where Jesus healed the blind man, found in the

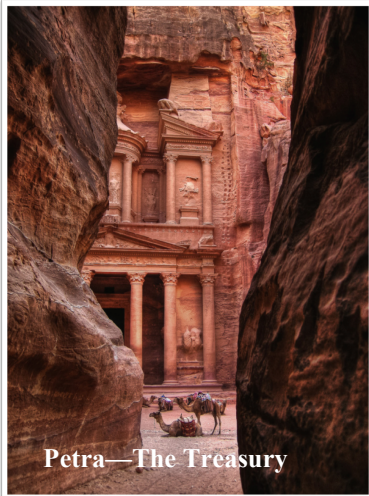


Gospel of John, 9:6—11. Then it's a short bus ride back to our hotel for another Israeli feast.

Day 10—Saturday, November 16th

PALM SUNDAY ROAD*GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE*GARDEN TOMB&GOLGATHA

After another amazing Israeli breakfast, we will bus to the top of the Mount of Olives and, in the footsteps of Jesus, walk down the **Palm Sunday Road** thru the breathtaking church of **Dominus Flavit**, known as the *Tear Drop Church*, where the Lord wept over His beloved city, Jerusalem. We conclude this spiritual highlight with devotions in the **Garden of Gethsemane**, the same place *Jesus prayed with His disciples before being betrayed*. Next door to the Garden of Gethsemane is the Church of All Nations, a working church built over the Rock of Agony where Jesus is said to have sweat drops of blood. After spending time where Jesus was betrayed, we will visit **Golgotha** and the **Garden Tomb**. There we will have the incredible experience of *celebrating communion next to the Empty Tomb*. A tomb thought to be like the one where Jesus was laid, a tomb that is empty. Then we will travel to the Allenby Bridge and cross from Israel into the Kingdom of Jordan, arriving in Petra for dinner and overnight at the beautiful Movenpick Park Hotel just outside the entrance to the incredible Red-Rose City of Petra.

Day 11—Sunday, November 17th

PETRA*WADI RUM

After an early Movenpick breakfast, we will enter the legendary Nabataean city of **Petra**, to where many Bible scholars believe the *Jewish remnant will flee during the tribulation and end times. (Revelation 11 & 12: 14—16)* Wreathed in mystery and sheltered from view by soaring, impenetrable rock cliffs, Petra's story is the stuff of legends, movies, myths, adventure and apocalypse. We will walk or ride down the only entrance, the Siq, as it winds its way almost one mile into the carved fortress. When you finally come to the Siq's end, Petra's most elaborate ruin, the Treasury rises before you. The Red-Rose City remained shielded from the outside world until 1812 when Swiss explorer, Jean Louis Burckhardt, disguised himself as a local Bedouin and walked down the now famous Siq, bringing Petra to the attention of the world once again. After visiting this ancient wonder we will enjoy a spectacular sunset tour, by 4x4 Jeep, of **Wadi Rum**, also known as the *Valley of the Moon*. Wadi Rum is another UNESCO Heritage site in Jordan featuring petro glyphs, inscriptions, archaeological sites, gorges, towering cliffs, and natural arches. Our day will end with a Bedouin desert dinner and overnight experience, including private tents, each with A/C and showers where we can stargaze and enjoy the quiet of Wadi Rum.

Day 12—Monday, November 18th

This morning we take our time for a last leisurely breakfast, enjoying the sights and beauty of Wadi Rum. Then we will travel to the Arava Border crossing between Jor-

dan and Israel at Eilat on the Red Sea. In the afternoon we fly from Eilat to Tel Aviv to meet our early morning flight back to the USA.

Day 13—Tuesday, November 19th—Return home with precious memories.

- 1) The **Single Room Supplement** is an additional cost if someone wants their own private single room or if someone has no roommate for any reason – they must pay the single supplement.
- 2) The **Land Only** cost means the person is in charge of arranging their own flights to and from Israel. The person must be prepared to meet the group at the Tel Aviv Airport on the specified date and time. After the tour ends, you must take care of your own flight leaving Tel Aviv. (The group flight usually leaves Tel Aviv Airport at approximately 1:00 AM on the last tour day)
- 3) **Travel Insurance is not included.** We strongly recommend that you obtain travel insurance. (i.e. Travelex Travel Insurance at www.travelexinsurance.com or Tin Leg Insurance at www.tinleg.com FYI: In order to cover trip cancellation, most travel insurance companies require insurance to be obtained within 21 days of your initial trip deposit.)
- 4) All **Passports** must be valid for 6 months after the tour end date.
- 5) Many countries have agreements with Israel exempting those travelers from Visa requirements i.e. USA, Mexico, you can check these requirements at www.goisrael.com
- 6) Each passenger must submit their name exactly as it is spelled on their passport. Mistakes in spelling or name changes will require a change fee for the passenger. This is an airline requirement.
- 7) If the fuel surcharge is raised, there may be additional costs for the trip.
- 8) The **Tour Price Excludes** the following: personal expenses such as travel insurance, internet costs, laundry, soft drinks, alcoholic beverages, meals and/or services other than listed.
- 9) This price is based on the current USD/Shekel rate. In case of drop of more than 3.5% in exchange rates, a price adjustment may be necessary. [HPT has never carried out this option]
- 10) In order to secure your space, a **deposit of \$750** per person is required with registration (February 2024). (*We will accept deposits until the tour is filled*)
- 11) **Total Final payment** is due Five months (June 2024) prior to departure
